



Coordinated Billing Program

To assist our members on fixed incomes in paying their electric bill, NEMEPA offers a Coordinated Billing Program.

This program allows qualifying members to choose the 5th or the 20th due date for their electric bills. This allows sufficient time to pay their bill after their retirement/benefit check arrives each month, avoiding the expense of forfeited discounts.

To qualify for participation in the Coordinated Billing Program:

1. Your monthly income check must be from a Federal, State, County, or City Government.
2. Your electric bill must be in your name.
3. Your electric bill must be paid in full each month.
4. Your account has not been disconnected for non-payment within the past twelve (12) months.
